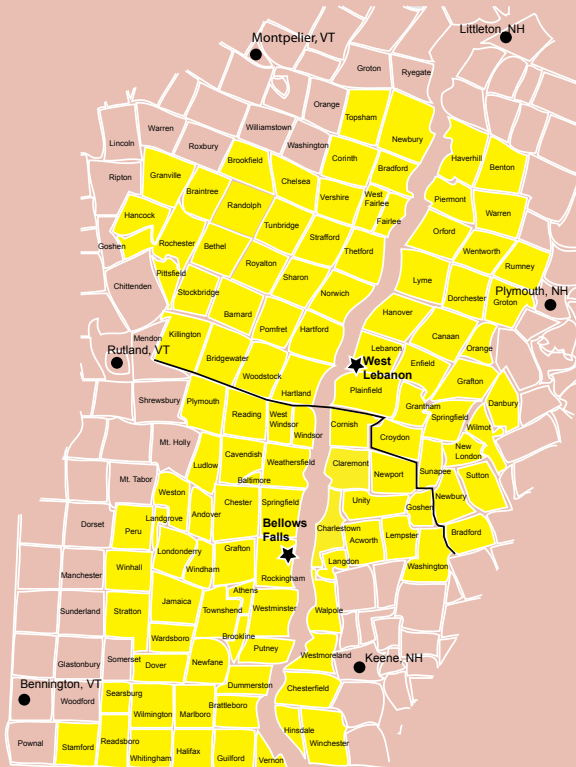

Visiting Nurse & Hospice Programs

Home Health Care

With a goal of promoting independence in the home, services are available to clients who are referred by a physician for short-term medical or rehab needs.

Long Term Care

Through this state program, we care for people with chronic medical problems, allowing them to live independently in the community.

Skilled Pediatric, Parent and Child Care

Pregnant women, new parents, babies and children are provided medical and support services that include well baby, preventative, and high-tech medical care. Pediatric hospice care is also lovingly provided.

Hospice

Focusing on comfort rather than cure, hospice is provided wherever the client resides – at home, in assisted living or in a nursing home. Patients can participate in choosing the type of care that will help them live as fully as possible, for all the time that remains.

Our hospice provides many programs, including bereavement care for families, Pet Peace of Mind and the Legacy Project, all of which can contribute profound meaning for patients and family.

Community Health Clinics

To benefit the communities we serve, we offer free or low-cost clinics throughout our service area. Nurses provide foot care, flu shots, blood pressure checks, and other needed wellness services.

Clinical Services

Our programs may include the following clinical services, which are all provided under the direction of a physician:

Skilled Nursing

Our nursing staff visits clients in their homes to assess physical condition and provide appropriate treatments and teaching, under the direction of a physician.

Physical Therapy

Therapists implement and monitor home exercise programs to promote rehabilitation following stroke, joint replacement surgery, injury or serious illness.

Occupational Therapy

Assessing home safety and accessibility, Occupational Therapists recommend adaptive equipment and home modifications to maximize independence.

Speech Therapy

Speech therapists assess and treat speech and communication problems as well as swallowing difficulties.

Medical Social Work

Coordinating community services for families and individuals, social workers help with problems associated with illness or the care of an ill person.

Personal Care

Home health aides and personal care attendants assist with daily personal care activities such as eating, bathing, dressing and exercising.
